

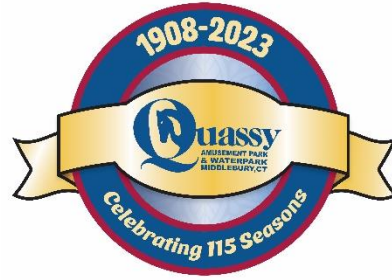

Quassy Hosts Annual Beach Party with 3-D Fireworks for Fourth of July

MIDDLEBURY, Conn. – Quassy Amusement Park and Waterpark is hosting its annual Blast at the Beach on Lake Quassapaug for its annual Fourth of July celebration. The event will include access to the beach, music, and a spectacular 3-D fireworks display.

For \$20 per person, guests get access to the beach party and the fireworks show 8:00 p.m. - 11:00 p.m. Fireworks will begin at 10:00 p.m. Food and beverages will also be available for purchase at Splash Away Bay Café. Discounted ride wristbands are also available for patrons for \$36.99 and will allow guests to enjoy attractions from 4:00 p.m. to 11:00 p.m.

To amplify the fireworks viewing experience, Quassy is handing out free 3-D glasses for paid beach party guests. For park guests who will not be attending the beach party but want to watch the fireworks show, there are plenty of places around the park to view fireworks. Park guests will also be able to purchase the 3D glasses for \$2. Proceeds benefit Give Kids the World Village, an 89-acre, nonprofit “storybook” resort in Kissimmee, FL for children with critical illnesses and their families to be treated to weeklong, cost-free vacations.
